VOLUNTEER EXPECTATIONS

- Safe supervisor of all dancers is our number one goal.
- Make sure all dancers are safe, respectful and are being kind to each other and volunteers.
- Help the room and the dancers get organized. Locate the Line Ups on the wall and become familiar with the order of the show. Cross off dances as they happen so your room knows where we are in the show order.
- Locate the speaker and make sure you can hear all announcements coming from upstairs. Make sure the speaker is turned up high enough for everyone to hear.
- Help dancers organize their costumes, especially if they have to make a change.
- Help dancers with make up and hair and make sure dancers that are leaving your room are stage ready. Hair spray, no wisps, red lipstick, blush, costume and hair are correct etc.
- If you see something that is not ok please let the room supervisor know and they will call for help. Do not let something that is not right continue for the entire show. Call for help so we can correct it.
- When dancers are waiting encourage them to stretch, get comfortable, clean up, organize games and make sure there aren't dancers that are feeling alone or left out.
- If you have a dancer that is upset and is having a hard time please radio for help and we can come up with an alternative plan for them. Don't let the entire night pass with an upset dancer.
- Remember this is EVERYONE's big night of the year so make sure the dancers are having fun and enjoying their evening. Remember that they are

excited and they are just kids so help them to behave but remember to also have fun.

- Help your room to stay organized by announcing 30 minutes until end of show, time to start organizing your stuff to go home. 20 minutes before the end of the show, time to start cleaning up and throwing trash away. 10 minutes until the end of the show time to start heading up to the stage for Bows and Awards.
- If you organize properly ahead of time when you return to your room after the Bows the kids can grab their belongings and head home. If the room is not organized the kids will spend a lot of time gathering their belongings and will most likely leave the room messy.
